Some of the causes are trauma, awkward posture skeletal irregularities and job related. The symptoms range from dull ache to stabling or shooting sensation, loss of bowel or bladder control numbness in the groin area or leg etc. Treatment of LBP varies, which include the following, Physical management, Medical, surgery and Physiotherapy and body massage. 10.0 **2018 NIGERIA CHAPTER SURVEY**

Data analysis of the Chapter survey was presented by the President Elect. He frowned at the poor participation of members. Out of over 200 plus active members only 29 members participated in the survey. Besides, most of the members in the 29 were executives.

He said it was quite unfortunate that members' interest is mostly on global PDC, although he appreciates it but advice that members should start from local to international. He re-emphasized the importance of unity, sense of purpose and commitment to Nigeria chapter progress.

To buttress his point on meeting attendance by members, he made an on the spot assessment of members that attended the meeting, Lagos attendees were few. He took time to explain the effects of decline in our numerical strength and its adverse consequence at global level.

The President and Mr. FEK Nakpodia contributed respectively to the analysis presented by the President Elect.

Sadeeq M.A. opined that the use of SMS should as well be used for the survey because quite often most people find it difficult or forget to visit their email boxes. This piece of advice was noted.

Additional anonymous suggestions on the propagation of the Nigeria chapter improvement are welcome. Good membership participation shall astronomically invigorate the chapter position at global level, the President Elect explained.

Kehinde Ologuntoye suggested use of media; send emails to old and new members. The President Elect clarified how ASSP runs, active, grace period and delete.

Akan Akan picked two points from the survey analysis – State coordinators, and community awareness. The crux of the matter is we are alive, how do we transfer what we learn to our immediate environment/community, this is important. He cited some examples of bad spots that are prone to accident hence the need to establish a platform where we can publish these observations.
